

INSTRUCTIONS AFTER SCAR REVISION

Local anesthesia will wear off over the next few hours.

You may have a small amount of oozing from your incision as the epinephrine in the local anesthesia wears off. This is normal.

You may need to take Tylenol or pain medication prescribed to you for local discomfort.

If your sutures are covered with Steri-Strips, they are to remain in place until the ends of the strips curl up. They may then fall off or you can remove them.

You may shower ONLY if you are able to keep the operative site completely dry. No bathing, soaking or swimming until your sutures have been removed.

If you have temporarily stopped taking coumadin or aspirin for this procedure, you may resume taking it today.

Notify this office if any of the following symptoms of infection occurs:

- Abnormal redness
- Chills

• Pain

• Fever

• Heat

- Swelling
- Foul-smelling drainage

Your scar will take several months to a year to heal completely and show your final result.
